

STANDARDISATION OF MEDICAL CHARGES - GUIDELINES

The SBI Officers' service Rules, while providing for full reimbursement of medical expenditure incurred by an Officer in respect of his own illness also lay down certain restrictions in this regard. The reimbursement of such expenses incurred in respect of dependent family shall be restricted to 75% of the expenses so incurred. Rule 24(3) also provides that when treatment is by a doctor other than an authorized doctor, reimbursement may be ordered at the discretion of the sanctioning authority to such extent as the authorized doctor considers the expenditure to be reasonable having regard to the circumstances of the case. Rule 24(4) states that visiting and consulting charges are reimbursable on such scales as may be laid down by the Bank from time to time for various centres. Rule 24 (6) states that Hospital and Nursing Home fees may be reimbursed to a reasonable extent depending upon the state of the officers. This Rule further states that except in emergency, prior approval of the authorized doctor is required to be obtained for treatment in Hospital/Nursing Home.

These rates were last revised in 2012 now these have revised vide Circular Letter No. CIRDO/HR/51 dated 16th January 2017.

2. Package deals of different hospitals have different specified items like mixed number of days in ICU/rooms and certain tests. If the patient has stayed more than the specified days and has availed other facilities such bills are required to be paid besides package charges as also for pre and post treatment separately as per entitlement.

Dental treatment like Gingivectomy, Flap, Inlays, Crowns, Bridges and Orthodontia etc. will be permitted only after submission of a detailed certificate from the consultant dental surgeon that such procedure is absolutely essential for treatment and prevention of a particular disease process and that without such treatment the general health of the patient will be adversely affected in the long run due to reasons to be given in each case. Charges as payable to MDS doctor will be payable only if the attending doctor has specialization in that field otherwise charges is applicable to BDS doctor will be payable. Charges for dental treatment applicable to MDS and BDS type of treatment, charges for radiology, diagnosis, treatment plan and procedures (image in charges has been given as per the nature and size of filling and surgical procedures implicated).
